Dear Parents and Carers,

We are so pleased that we are finally having some sunshine and bright weather! Please make sure your child has a labelled water bottle in school and a sunhat on hot days. It is also helpful if you apply suncream to your children before bringing them in. If you need your child to apply suncream during the day, they will need to do this themselves as our staff are unable to do this for them.

We have recently been developing a Communication Policy which outlines the procedures around communication between parents and school. We are aware that parents don't always know the best person to contact with a query so this policy outlines who to contact and the contact details you will need. It also outlines the expectations in terms of a response from school and what communication you can expect to receive from us. It is worth noting that it states clearly in the policy that individual members of staff should not be emailed as we cannot always guarantee that emails to individuals will be picked up depending on working patterns, sickness, workload etc. All urgent queries should be a phone call to the school office and the majority of emails should be sent to admin@manorpark.coventry.sch.uk in the first instance. Seesaw messaging should only be used for non-urgent issues relating to your child's learning or pastoral support. The policy has been ratified by our governors and has been attached for your reference.

We have also reviewed our Parent Code of Conduct which outlines the conduct which is expected when on the school site and communicating with school. This has also been attached for your reference. Have a wonderful weekend!
