Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our Rising from the Rubble topic, we have arranged for Year 6 children to visit Coventry Cathedral and the Transport Museum. Pupils will have the opportunity to make comparisons of the new and old cathedral, learn about the night of the blitz and experience what it was like to be an evacuee during WW2.

The visit will take place on 16th Sept for Class 22, 17th September for Class 21 and 24th September for Class 23 We will leave school at approximately 9:15am and will be back at school by 3:30pm. The cost of the trip is £7.00 per child, or £3.50 if you are registered as Pupil Premium. If insufficient contributions do not cover the cost of the trip and there is no alternative method to make up the shortfall, then the activity/trip could be cancelled. In the event of cancellation then all money received will be refunded.

Please make payment and give your consent via SIMS Pay; it will be listed under the trips heading. If you are unable to do this, then please contact the school office who will be happy to assist.

As we are away all day, your child will need to bring a packed lunch preferably in a named, disposable bag. If your child normally has a free school meal, we can arrange for them to receive a packed lunch on that day, but advance notice needs to be given to the school office at least 3 days prior to the trip.

The children will need to wear their school uniform and please ensure they have a coat as we will be walking to the venue and back.

We are really excited to once again be able to offer our children these learning experiences outside of the classroom. The children will be staying within their class bubble and we will ensure hand sanitisation and social distancing measures are followed throughout the day.
