A message from our Headteacher: Jill O'Connor

Dear Parents and Carers,

You will no doubt have heard that the NEU, one of the teaching unions, has now given notice for a series of national and regional strikes. The union will be calling on their teacher members to take strike action on the following dates:

- Wednesday February 1st (National strike)
- Wednesday 1st March (West Midlands Regional strike)
- Wednesday 15th and Thursday 16th March (National strikes)

We do not have any details at the moment regarding whether we will be affected by this industrial action. We will of course update you as soon as possible if we hear that any of our teaching staff will be involved in strike action, which could cause disruption to some classes across school. We will continue to work very closely with the local authority on this matter.

I would like to remind you about our spring parents' evenings which will be held on Tuesday 14th February and Wednesday 15th February between 4 -6.30pm. We will be offering a hybrid model of meetings, and will once again take feedback from parents as to their preferred way of meeting their child's class teacher. The meetings on Tuesday evening will be offered as remote appointments, with face- to -face meetings on Wednesday. Appointments are now open on the online system for you to book, so please book a time that is convenient for you.

We are holding a reading parent workshop on Thursday 26th January at 4.45pm in the lower hall. This is an excellent opportunity for parents of children in reception to find out how we teach phonics and early reading through our highly successful reading teaching programmes. Do come along to the lower hall on this date to find out more information. We hope to hold a follow-on session for parents with children in Key Stage 1 later in the term.

Year 6 are very excited about their WOW event to enrich their topic which will be a visit to school from a polar explorer on Thursday.

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Learning in Nursery



Last week during Manor Park University the children in the animal care course enjoyed making bird feeders.







Emotion Coaching is an approach that parents/carers can use with children and young people to support their emotional development. Research suggests that Emotion Coached children and young people:

- Are more emotionally stable
- Are more resilient
- Achieve more academically in school
- Have fewer behavioural problems

This session will introduce the steps of Emotion Coaching and its scientific basis, and will involve practical activities and resource-sharing so that parents can begin to use this increasingly popular approach straight after the session.


