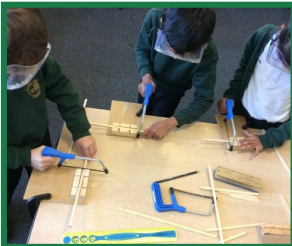
Learning in Reception

Manor Park University

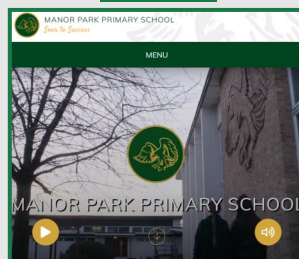
