
## Soar to Success—Self-Sufficient, Original, Attitude, Resilient

### Learning in Nursery

This week we have been learning about how to be a good friend using the text 'The Gingerbread Man'. We spoke about some kind things we could do to help our friends if they were feeling sad and how we can play nicely together.



This week in Reception we have been investigating what has happened to our water area outside. Walking in a Winter Wonderland!

## Learning in Year 2

This week children in Year 2 have been working scientifically. They completed a hand span investigation where they asked and answered questions and recorded and interpreted results. Ask Year 2 about their hand spans and how many cubes they can hold in each hand!

#### Learning in Year 3

This week in Year 3 we composed a soundtrack for a piece of film showing the Greek soldier Pheidippides running 26 miles from Marathon to Athens. We learnt the meanings of the words tempo, pitch, dynamics and rhythm, and experimented with them to create a piece of music.

### Learning in Year 4

This week in Year 4 we had great fun learning about and then creating mosaic tiles! We stamped our tiles individually and then joined them together to create one large class design.

### Learning in Year 5

Year 5 loved testing their hieroglyphics knowledge by cracking codes all around the school. The children used what they had learned to create their own cartouches in class. They really are experts on ancient Egypt now!



## Learning in Year 6

This week in Year 6 we have been learning all about VE Day and how the end of WWII was celebrated across the nation. We spent time doing our own research into how the end of the war came about, and the highs and lows of the weeks and years following this momentous event in history. Once we had gathered our information, we took some time to present it beautifully in our creative curriculum books.
