Tuesday 5th January - Urgent Update

Following the Prime Minister's announcement this evening. I have to inform you that Manor Park will be closed to the vast majority of pupils from tomorrow, Tuesday 5th January.

This is a step that we anticipated to an extent (which is why the key worker and vulnerable groups letter was sent earlier today) but not within such a short timescale.

The next day or so is going to involve a significant effort in planning and organisation such that we can quickly and effectively reach a position where we are able to offer remote education to the large majority of pupils at home whilst also maintaining some provision in school for vulnerable children and for children of key workers.

If you have a key worker or have a child who can be classed as vulnerable, we are asking you to keep your child with you at home tomorrow **if this is at all possible**. This is to facilitate school staff in turning around the work required to get our provision ready for all as quickly as possible. If your child (key worker and vulnerable children) absolutely cannot stay at home, they can come to school at the normal time, in the normal way and go to their normal classroom, uniform must be worn. Dinners will be available and CHAMPS provision will remain open.

Please note - no other child can attend from tomorrow under any circumstances until further notice.

Online learning will be provided via SeeSaw from 9am tomorrow morning. If you require a code to access your child's account please email - admin@manorpark.coventry.sch.uk
