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# **Nursery Nativity**

We have been receiving lots of letters from story characters in Nursery to inspire the children to use their imaginations to do lots of creative work. We have been opening the letters and reading them together with the children. We will continue to change books on a Monday for children who remember to bring their borrowed books back into school.

Next week we will be modelling how to make lists. We will be playing circle games where the children all take turns sharing their favourite things such as food, games and toys. We will also be playing 'Silly Rhyming Strings' where we say a list of rhyming words with an 'odd one out' at the end for the children to spot. Our maths work will focus on careful counting and number recognition. The children are enjoying singing the number ditties and using their fingers and whiteboard pens to trace over the numbers. They are also going to be counting, drawing and writing the numbers to match for small sets of everyday objects such as 3 stars etc.
