### In Communication, Language and Literacy I will be learning to:

Develop a wider knowledge of vocabulary relating to my own interests, experiences and topics

Be a good listener

### In Personal, Social and Emotional Development, I will be learning to:

Talk about my own feelings and respond to the wishes and feelings of others

We will be exploring how materials change when they are heated through mixing and baking. We are going to make salt dough festive decorations by mixing ingredients and baking.

Explore numbers in stories, number rhymes and in the environment

### In Literacy I will be learning to:

Develop my fine motor skills when using pencils, scissors, paint brushes, threading and puzzles etc.

Tune into sounds in the environment and take part in rhyming activities

Use my emergent writing skills when mark making, during role play activities and sensory play

### In Expressive Arts and Design, I will be learning to:

Take part in dancing, singing and performing involving role play and musical activities

Explore colours, painting and collage

Talk about my creative work with enjoyment and developing vocabulary
