In Communication, Language and Literacy I will be learning to:

*Listen to stories and rhymes with increasing attention and recall
Follow directions and simple instructions with growing accuracy and understanding
Begin to use more detailed sentences when talking about my interests and experiences
Develop a wider knowledge of vocabulary relating to my own interests, experiences and topics*

In Personal, Social and Emotional Development, I will be learning to:

*Be confident to talk about my own choices and interests
Welcome praise for my own achievements
Be confident to ask for help and support from adults
Express my own feelings and emotions
Share a range of play experiences with others
Cope with changes in routines and activities*

In Physical Development I will be learning to:

*Develop different ways of moving confidently and with growing control including running, skipping, climbing, balancing and spatial awareness
Take part in physical play activities including team games, dance and movement
Be independent when dressing for a range of different activities*

In Understanding the World, I will enjoy:

*Exploring the natural environment
Celebrating similarities and differences with my friends and familiar adults
Using simple technology to support my learning including Bee Bot programmable toys and the interactive whiteboard*

In Literacy I will be learning to:

*Talk about favourite stories and rhymes with growing understanding and recall
Repeat words or phrases from familiar stories
Take part in early phonics activities including rhyming, alliteration, environmental sounds
Begin to match letters and sounds*

In Expressive Arts and Design, I will be learning to:

*Construct safely, horizontally and vertically, making enclosures and spaces
Create pictures and talk about my work
Engage in imaginative role play based on my own experiences and stories
Explore small world landscapes relating to topic and my own interests*

In Maths I will be learning to:

*Recite number names in sequence during play and group activities
Explore numbers in the environment
Develop accurate counting, number recognition, matching and practical adding and subtracting when using everyday objects
Use the language of size, shape and space during my play and creative activities*

In Communication, Language and Literacy I will be learning to:
Use a range of vocabulary relating to our topic and the changing seasons
Talk about my ideas and observations with increasing confidence and understanding
Take part in activities where I can explore different sounds including sounds in the environment and by using percussion instruments

In Personal, Social and Emotional Development, I will be learning to:
Play with a group of friends on shared interests including role play and creative work
Help others including my friends and teachers in nursery
Choose resources carefully to carry out fun tasks and to use equipment with growing care and control

In Expressive Arts and Design, I will be learning to:
Use a range of creative tools and materials to make models of eggs including giant dragon eggs
Use a range of construction equipment and junk modelling to build castles, palaces and caves
Create Easter cards and cakes

In Physical Development I will be learning to:
Be confident to tell adults when I am tired or hungry
Talk about my favourite food and begin to understand how certain foods help me to grow and stay healthy
Begin to notice the effects of activity when I am using my body during physical play
Take part in P.E. activities in the school hall including team games, dance and movement

In Literacy I will be learning to:
Share a range of stories with a focus on imaginary settings including castles and palaces
Role play characters from stories including princes, knights, princesses and dragons
Take part in early phonics activities including rhyming, alliteration, and environmental sounds
Begin to match letters and sounds

In Understanding the World, I will enjoy:
Exploring life cycles and how plants and animals grow and develop
Observe how eggs change and hatch over time
Show care and concern for living things
Understand how celebrations can be shared and enjoyed including the Easter story and traditions

In Maths I will be learning to:
Do lots of fun activities in the outdoor area including traditional playground games including hopscotch and 'What's the time Mr Wolf?'
Explore shape space and measures in my practical activities using sand, water and in the mud kitchen
Explore counting and number recognition by using toys, objects of interest, songs and rhymes
