In Literacy I will be learning to:

Develop my phonics skills to read and write simple words and sentences Write about stories using imagination and simple story language Continue rhyming strings Read my own writing which has been writter during my independent work and guided group activities Recognise and understand print in the environment

In Expressive Arts and Design, I will learn to: Create simple representations of events, people and objects Build using various construction materials Use percussion instruments to experiment with how sounds can be made and altered Listen to music from different cultures and experiment with dance and movement In Understanding the Warld, I will be learning to:

Show an interest in the wider world and in the lives of people who are familiar to me Talk about why things happen and how things work Experience a range of cultures through stories, celebrations and traditions In Maths I will be learning to: Use numbers to 10 and beyond in a range of maths activities including counting, matching, ardering, addition and subtraction and when writing simple number sentences Know one more and one less than a given number to 5, 10 and 20 Order everyday items by length or height Use familiar objects and common shapes to create patterns and build models.

to complete written and creative work

In Expressive Arts and Design, I will learn to: Be creative through role play,

music, dance and art activities Use malleable materials to create muddy mixtures, pies and cakes following simple recipes in the mud kitchen

Explore fine motor and creative skills using a range of wool, ribbons and paper for simple weaving

Share a range of festivals and traditions including Easter

In Understanding the World, I will be learning to: Consider where some food comes from including farms, orchards and oceans Explore what happens to food over

time and when placed in different conditions
