## Next Week:

We are impressed at how hard the children are working in school. They all have so much enthusiasm for learning and working together with their friends and teachers. We will be uing to teach phonics, reading and writing each day.



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Next week, we have planned lots of games and writing opportunities for the children to help them to recognise some of the characters and their matching names from the Oxford Reading Tree books that the children are reading. We will be teaching the children to find familiar words in word searches and write simple words by listening carefully to each sound, using their developing segmenting and blending skills. The children will have opportunities to share different styles of books and stories and we will support them to talk about the characters, settings and illustrations. We will also be encouraging the children to explore autumn colours and colour mixing during their creative work. They will use paints and collage materials to make their own pictures and artwork. One of our next topics that we will be focussing on is 'Mirror, Mirror!' The children will have lots of opportunities to take part in carefully planned investigations and creative work based on this theme. We would be very grateful if you could send into school any shiny/sparkly things that you may have e.g. tin foil, shiny wrappers, card etc.

We are encouraging the children to use lots of new words relating to their work in school. Some key vocabulary for this topic is shiny, sparkly, reflection, light, moon and stars etc. It would be wonderful if you could explore some more vocabulary with your child at home.
