The Wild Woods

History

- Research and make a poster about a real-life superhero from the past who did something incredible or extraordinary: it could be a paralympian athlete; a person who helped others like Florence Nightingale; a person who climbed a huge mountain or rescued someone.

Geography

- What physical and human features can you find around your local area or near your home? Can you draw them and label them?

D&T

- Draw and design a superhero city then build it using construction like lego or building bricks. Take a photo of what you have built.
- Prepare a healthy meal - savoury or sweet - to keep a superhero or your family members healthy. Take a photo of what you have created and write the recipe.



Art

- Can you make your own reptile or fish?
- Draw or paint a woodland animal of your choice.
- Create an autumn collage picture using a range of materials.



Science

- Go for a walk in a local park, in the countryside or places near to your home then identify and name some of the trees that you have been learning about. Take photos and label what you have found.
- Can you research and write facts about your favourite mammal, amphibian, bird, fish, reptile or woodland animal?



PSHE

Create a superhero obstacle course where you can run, jump and move in different ways.
 Why is it important to do exercise?
 What else can we do to keep ourselves healthy? (mentally and physically) - create a poster.
