

# FLASHBACK

YEAR 1

SUMMER TERM

## English

Throughout this term the children will be studying a variety of genres including narratives, instructions, non-chronological reports and poetry. We will be using a range of high quality texts to inspire the children's writing across the term. The children will be building upon, and applying skills they have learnt so far this year and becoming increasingly more independent with their writing. We will be supporting the children with being able to develop their writing by including and using a range of descriptive vocabulary, punctuation and applying their phonics to their spelling.

## Maths

This term, children will be securing and consolidating their knowledge on areas of maths they have covered throughout the year. We will be revisiting our basic number skills of the four operations as well as deepening their understanding by problem solving and reasoning. Children will continue to practice counting forwards and backwards, as well as counting in jumps of 2s, 5s and 10s. We will also be focusing on time to half an hour, measuring mass, length and capacity, using positional language such as half turn and quarter turns, as well as finding fractions of shapes and amounts.

## Humanities

### Geography

Children will be naming and locating the four countries of the UK, as well as identifying characteristics and landmarks of each country. Children will also be using aerial photographs and maps to identify and locate human and physical characteristics.

### History

As part of our topic, we will be learning about changes in living memory from babyhood to our current age, as well as 'flashing back' to events beyond our living memory, including the Great Fire of London and the Millennium.

## RE

This term we will be exploring the question 'What makes some places sacred?' linked to Christianity and Sikhism.

## Computing

In computing this term, we will be consolidating our knowledge of algorithms to write our own and debug algorithms given to us. We will also be using the laptops to secure our typing skills, as well as creating and storing digital content.

## The Arts

### Art

Children will be developing our art techniques to draw and paint a self and family portrait. We will be learning about the artist Pieter Bruegel, we will be recreating one of his famous paintings 'Children's Games'.

### Music

This term, we will be using and applying all our music skills to listen, compose and perform our own piece of music using tuned and un-tuned instruments linked to the song 'London's Burning'.

### Design and Technology

For our D&T project this term, we will be using and applying our D&T skills to design and make our own Jack in the Box and then evaluate it.

## PSHE

This term, children will be learning about fire safety, hazards around the home and consent. We will also be learning about online safety, anti-bullying and mental health.

## Science

This term, we will be identifying our body parts and senses. We will be investigating different materials linked to the Great Fire of London as well as revisiting the seasons as it turns to summer
