- Design and build your own Greek temple using lego or recycled materials.
- What did ancient Greeks eat? How does this differ to what people in Greece eat now? Choose a Greek recipe that is typically eaten today, buy the ingredients and have a go at making it.

- Make a stop-motion animation to showcase a particular area of your learning that has interested you.
- Choose an area of your ancient Greek learning which has particularly interested you. Use an app of your choice to present your learning in a creative way.

Geography

- Create a fact file about the geography of Greece. Think about where it is situated in the world as well as human and physical features. You might decide to make a 3D model instead!
- Create a travel guide encouraging readers to visit Greece. Think about the weather, attractions, cuisine and anything else which would attract tourists!

- Research the Acropolis in Athens. Who was it built for? What was it used for? What happened to it? What parts remain? Present your findings however you would like.
- Research Greek myths and choose your favourite. Recreate the story (or part of it) however you would like. You could write an exciting narrative, create an animation, act out the story or create a comic.
