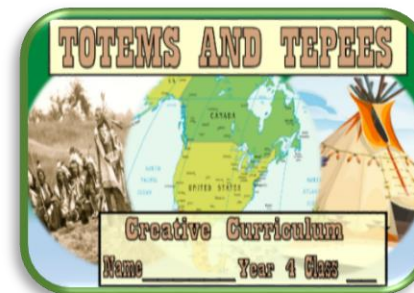




Year 4 Summer Term
