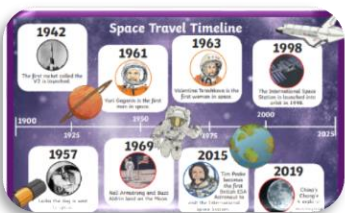
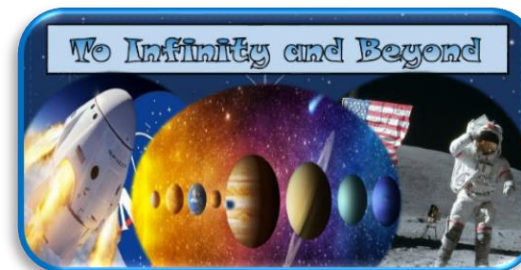




## Year 5 Spring Term
