ENGLISH

MATHS

This term, we will continue to develop and refine your arithmetic skills by securing your knowledge of the four operations. Understanding these concepts will allow you to apply your learning to further mathematical problems. It is vital that you are able to apply your learning to a variety of tasks so we will therefore follow our Manor Park mastery model of representing, fluency and reasoning to enhance your confidence in this area.
