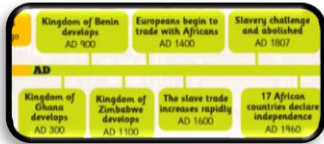

Create a timeline of Benin's history including pictures and key dates. You can present this on paper or on an app of your choice.



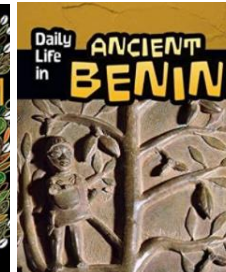
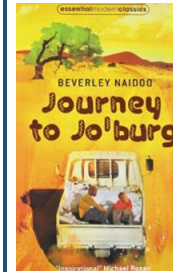
